2. <u>DISCUSSION OF ISSUES RELATING TO THE DOW ACTIVE COMPLEX (THE DAC)</u>
<u>BUSINESS PLAN</u> – Parks and Recreation Director Kenny Walsh gave an overview of the plans pertaining to the logistics of staffing for the new facility, facility amenities and programs, facility hours and days of operations and also provided the recommended facility membership fees. The conservative estimate for the first year of the new facility could potentially generate \$930,000 in new revenue.

Councilwoman Ford asked about having membership contracts for the fees. Mr. Walsh stated the contracts are not binding and there will be a withdrawal process. The Avon Center and Maxwell Center will continue to operate as usual along with the equipment for each facility.

3. PRESENTATION OF A PROJECT UPDATE FOR THE NEW COURT HOUSE BUILDING BY PROJECT LUONG ARCHITECTS, LLC. – Luong Architect representative, Yesika Soto, presented an update on the status and design of the new court house building detailing the inspiration for the logo, structure and color choice for the outside of the building along with a description of the interior design.
