Why Charge Fees?

- The City currently absorbs all processing fees, with the exception of Municipal Court transactions.
- For Central Collections, the Police Department, Public Works and EMS, these fees are charged at a rate of 0.43% + \$0.43 on top of bank and card brand fees.
- Online utility payments are charged an additional \$1.25 per transaction.
- In Quarter 3, this resulted in \$60,706 in processing fees and \$21,688 in Insite Fees.
- To have recovered the cost of the processing fees alone, a 2.5% fee would have been necessary.
- Credit card fees for utility payments increased year over year from fiscal year (FY) 2022 to 2023 by 29%, then another 13% in 2024. An additional 3% increase is projected in FY 2025. This is a 50% increase from FY 2022 to FY 2025.

Alternative Payment Methods Available to Customers

Available Payment Methods for Utility Billing Are:

- Credit Card (On-Your-Own Online, Auto-Draft Online, Text-To-Pay, Interactive Voice Response [IVR/phone], In-Person), Cash, Check, Money Order, Bank Draft.
- Echecks can be added as a payment option. This cost \$1.95 per transaction. Echecks can be set up to auto-draft online.
- Zelle, Paypal, Cashapp, etc. are not compatible with Tyler Technologies at this time.

Available Payment Methods for Public Works Are:

 Credit Card (On-Your-Own Online, In-Person), Cash (at Central Collections Window), Check, Money Order.

Available Payment Methods for EMS Are:

Credit Card (On-Your-Own Online, In-Person), Cash, Check,
 Money Order, Electronic Funds Transfer.

- Credit cards are the predominant payment method for Utility Billing and Public Works transactions.
 - Of the Utility Billing credit card transactions, on-your-own online credit card payments contribute to 57% of the usage, with the online credit card auto-draft option contributing to 36%.
- EFT payments the predominant payment method for EMS Transactions.

Conclusion

- Charging a processing fee to the customers choosing to pay with a credit card would alleviate the City's budget for credit card fees in the General Fund and Water and Sewer Fund allowing for these funds to be used for other purposes.
- Assessing a fee would be a more equitable solution to recover these costs directly from customers choosing this payment option vs. subsidizing these fees across the entire water/sewer rate structure.
- There are a number of other payment options available for customers to utilize that do not incur a fee.
- There is precedent to charge a fee based on what we see surrounding cities doing. 8 out of the 12 cities surveyed charge a processing fee. All 4 tax offices surveyed charge a processing fee.
- Fees will only apply to Central Collection (excluding tax payments), Public Works, the Police Department and EMS. This
 change will not affect any Parks and Rec programs or facilities.
- If the fee passes Council's approval, communication would be included in the next several water bills, on the City's website, payment portal website, and social media platforms allowing customers to switch their payment option before the fee is imposed. Suggested start date would be November 1st or December 1st.
