<u>CALL TO ORDER</u> – Mayor Mouton called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

<u>CONSENT CALENDAR</u> – Motion was made by Councilman Ginn and seconded by Councilman Haight to approve the consent calendar as follows:

3. CONSIDERATION OF AND ACTION ON ENTERING INTO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH TEXAS DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT (TDEM) FOR MEDICAL SERVICES DIRECTOR SERVICES – Motion was made by Councilwoman Ford and seconded by Councilman League to authorize entering into an interlocal agreement with Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM) for Medical Services Director services.

Motion carried 7 to 0.

4. CONSIDERATION OF AND ACTION ON AN AGREEMENT WITH NEXT LEVEL URGENT CARE (NLUC, PLLC) – Motion was made by Councilman Ginn and seconded by Councilman Martin to authorize an agreement with Next Level Urgent Care (NLUC, PLLC).

Motion carried 7 to 0.

5. CONSIDERATION OF AND ACTION ON CASTING THE CITY OF DEER PARK'S VOTE IN THE ELECTION OF A MEMBER ON THE TEXAS MUNICIPAL LEAGUE BOARD OF DIRECTORS FOR REGION 14 – Motion was made by Councilwoman Garrison and seconded by Councilman Martin on casting the City of Deer Park's vote in the election of member Sally Branson on the Texas Municipal League Board of Directors for Region 14.

6. CONSIDERATION OF AND ACTION ON PURCHASING OPENGOV WORKORDER/ASSET MANAGEMENT SOFTWARE FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS STREET MAINTENANCE AND WATER & SEWER MAINTENANCE DIVISIONS VIA TX-DIR CONTRACT DIR-CPO-5327 – Motion was made by Councilman League and seconded by Councilwoman Ford to approve purchasing OpenGov workorder/asset management software for the Public Works Street Maintenance and Water & Sewer Maintenance Divisions via TX-DIR contract DIR-CPO-5327.

Motion carried 7 to 0.

7. CONSIDERATION OF AND ACTION OF APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF EXPANSION SHELVES FOR THE CITY'S STOREONCE DATA STORAGE DEVICES FROM DATAVOX LLC VIA DIR CONTRACT NUMBER DIR-TSO-4160 – Motion was made by Councilman Ginn and seconded by Councilman Haight on approving the purchase of expansion shelves for the City's StoreOnce data storage devices from Datavox LLC via DIR contract number DIR-TSO-4160.

Motion carried 7 to 0.

8. CONSIDERATION OF AND ACTION ON THE PURCHASE OF A 2025 FORD F-450 DIESEL CHASSIS AND PATIENT COMPARTMENT THROUGH HGAC CONTRACT #AM10-23 – Motion was made by Councilman League and seconded by Councilman Martin to authorize the purchase of a 2025 Ford F-450 Diesel Chassis and Patient Compartment through HGAC Contract #AM10-23.
