AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN PORTIONS OF SECTION 106-25 (b)(c) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF DEER PARK, TEXAS, CONCERNING WATER AND SEWER RATES; PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATES; PROVIDING A REPEALER

CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEER PARK:

ARTICLE I.

Effective for all water passing through the meter after October 1, 2025, Section 106-25 (b) (c) of

the Code of Ordinances of the City of Deer Park, Texas are hereby amended in accordance to Schedule "A"

attached hereto and are due and payable on or before the twentieth day of each month. All water that passes

through the meter shall be charged according to Schedule "A" whether or not water is used.

ARTICLE II.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

ARTICLE III.

If any provision, exception, section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this

Ordinance, or the application of same to any person or set of circumstances shall, for any reason, be held

unconstitutional, void or invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of

this Ordinance, or their application to other persons or sets of circumstances and, to this end, all provisions

of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

ARTICLE IV.

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was adopted,

was open to the public and the public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given, all

as required by Chapter 551 of the Government Code of the State of Texas.
