<u>CALL TO ORDER</u> – Mayor Mouton called the workshop to order at 6:45 p.m.

City Council left for Executive Session at 6:45 pm and returned to open session at 7:06 pm with no action taken.

2. <u>DISCUSSION OF ISSUES RELATING TO THE NEW STREET SIGN PROGRAM AND INTERSECTION MASTS</u> – City Manager James Stokes addressed council to discuss the concerns with the new signs changed out on Luella. Citizens have commented that the font is too small and they are not easy to view. Public Works Director David Van Riper brought in several sign options for council to view: some were 4-inch font (original), 5-inch font, 6-in font, and changed the logo to white and moving the placement of the logo (see photo below). After some discussion, council agreed they preferred sign option no. 2 which is a 5-inch font

with the sign measuring 10x36 inches (see photo below). The new poles will not need to be changed out as the new signs will still fit on them. It was agreed to replace all current signs and then going forward with the new sign design. Mr. Van Riper stated that 82 signs have been replaced so far this year (original design). Council stated they wanted the sign replacements for entire city to be done under a five-year period.

Intersection mast replacement discussion occurred. A scope of work will be done for each intersection. It is estimated to cost about \$250k for each intersection. Once completed, we can do want we want on our own poles (i.e. lights, etc). Staff will bring back scope of work information on this project at a later council workshop.
