CALL TO ORDER – Mayor Mouton called the workshop to order at 7:00 p.m.

COMMENTS FROM AUDIENCE – No comments received.

1. SPECIAL PRESENTATION RECOGNIZING THE 2025 DEER PARK SEMINOLES (SENIORS) FOR WINNING THE SUPER BOWL. – Mayor Mouton recognized the 2025 Deer Park Seminoles (Seniors) for winning the Super Bowl. They beat Shadow Creek Titans 24-12 in the Super Bowl. The Head Coach Jeraco Johnston spoke about the team and that this was his last season coaching the Seminoles. Each of the players introduced themselves and photos were taken.
2. DISCUSSION OF ISSUES RELATING TO THE PURCHASE, INSTALLATION AND MONITORING OF AN AMBIENT AIR MONITORING SYSTEM IN THE CITY OF DEER PARK.– Emergency Management Director Jamie Galloway spoke to council on this topic. The fixed ambient air monitoring system would consist of four (4) stationary monitors and two (2) handheld units that can be deployed in the field. The City of Deer Park received a Port Security Grant for reimbursement totaling \$82,500 to help offset the total cost. The original plan was to go with a vendor that was on the cooperative plan but it was determined that the vendor or the equipment was not on that cooperative plan. Mr. Galloway explained that the Request for Proposal is being used and will be published in the newspaper on 12/24 & 12/31 with the opening of the bids in January 2026. The system they are looking at is similar to the one used in Galena Park.

ADJOURN – Prior to adjourning, City Manager Stokes introduced the current intern, Joseph Quartey and his wife and spoke about his accomplishments and purpose.


Mayor Mouton adjourned the workshop meeting at 7:22 p.m.
