DEER PARK POLICE DEPARTMENT has adopted a detailed written policy on racial profiling. Our policy:

- 1) clearly defines acts constituting racial
- 2) strictly prohibits peace officers employed by the DEER PARK POLICE DEPARTMENT from in racial profiling;
- 3) implements a process by which an individual may file a DEER PARK POLICE DEPARTMENT if the individual believes that a peace officer employed by the DEER PARK POLICE DEPARTMENT has engaged in racial profiling with respect to the individual;
- 4) provides public education relating to the agency's complaint
- 5) requires appropriate corrective action to be taken against a peace officer DEER PARK POLICE DEPARTMENT who, after an investigation, is shown to have engaged in racial profiling in violation of the DEER PARK POLICE DEPARTMENT policy;
- 6) requires collection of information relating to motor vehicle stops in which a citation is issued to arrests made as a result of those stops, including information relating to:
  - a. the race or ethnicity of the individual
  - b. whether a search was conducted and, if so, whether the individual detained consented the search;

- c. whether the peace officer knew the race or ethnicity of the individual detained detaining that individual;
- d. whether the peace officer used physical force that resulted in bodily injury during the
- e. the location of the stop;
- f. the reason for the stop.

7) requires the chief administrator of the agency, regardless of whether the administrator is employed, or appointed, to submit an annual report of the information collected under Subdivision (6) to:

- a. the Commission on Law Enforcement;
- b. the governing body of each county or municipality served by the agency, if the agency an agency of a county, municipality, or other political subdivision of the state.

The DEER PARK POLICE DEPARTMENT has satisfied the statutory data audit requirements as prescribed in Article 2.133(c), Code of Criminal Procedure during the reporting period.
