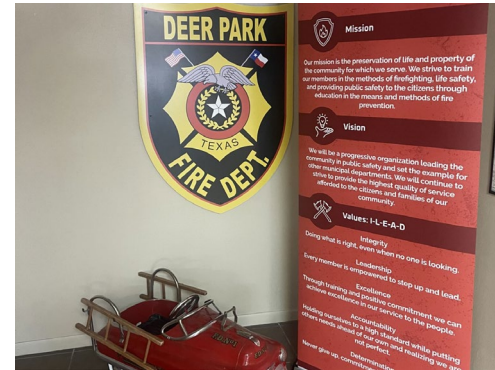

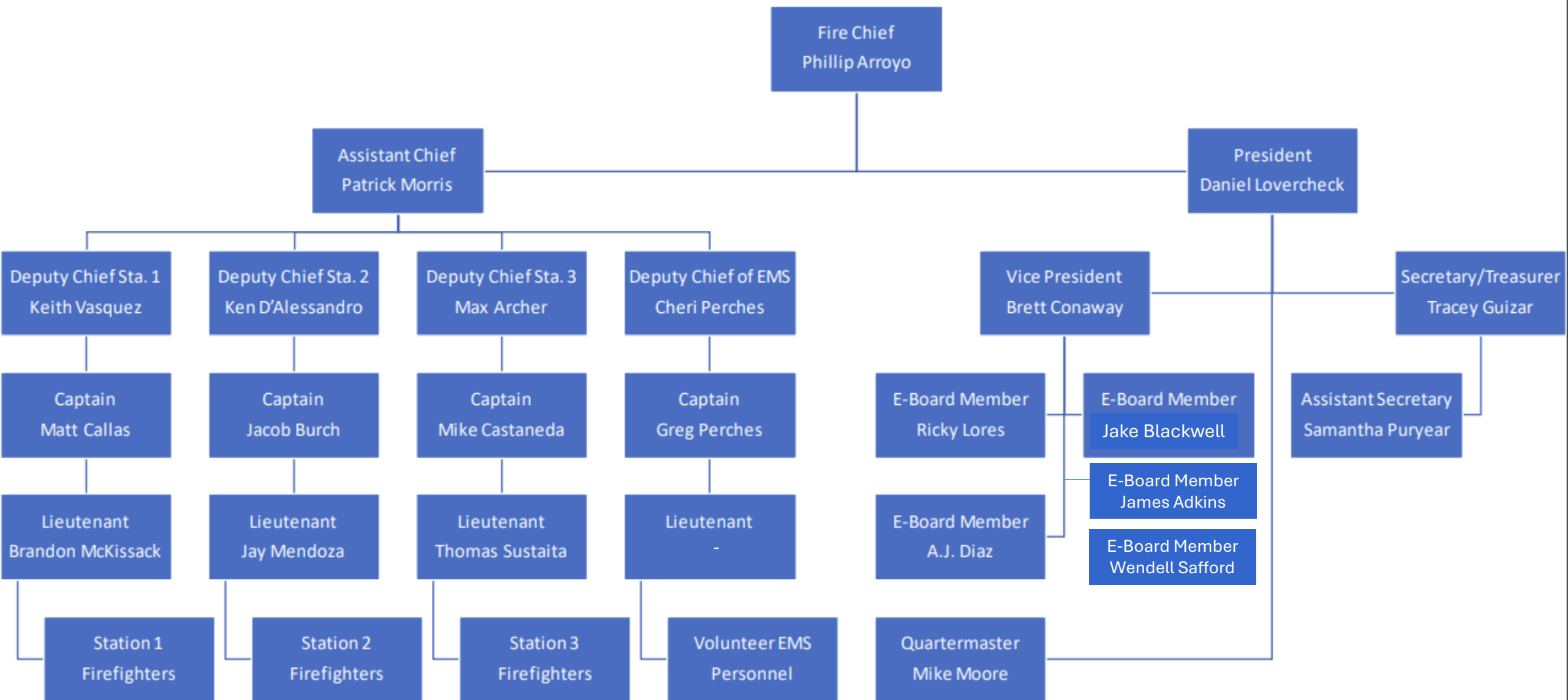

City of Deer Park Volunteer Fire Department Organizational Chart

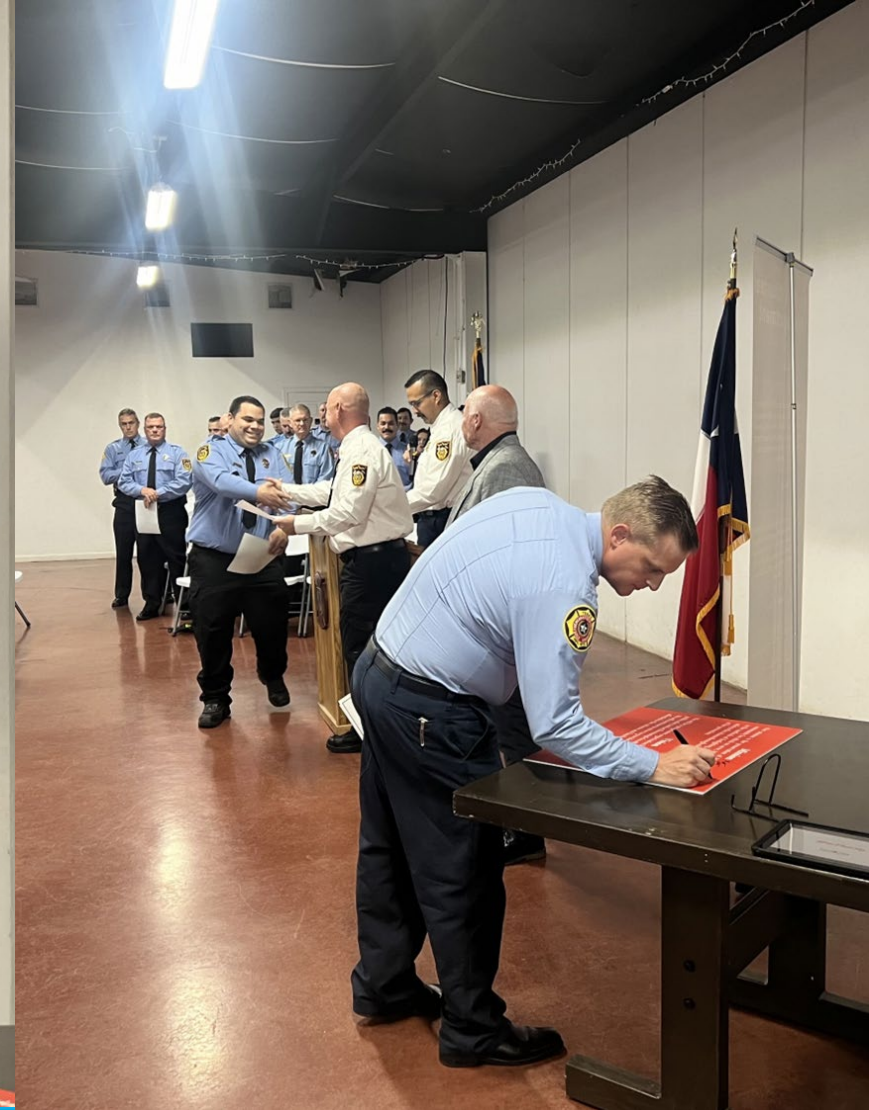


LEADERS, LEADING

Officer Elections held in 2024 – We are appreciative of those who served in past positions and continue to serve in leadership capacities. We have added two appointed positions (Communication Specialist –Greg Bridges and Industrial Liaison –Don Davis). New duties/tasks have been assigned to all officers including the following expectations and viewpoints:

- Each officer must Attend at minimum 1 external in-person training on behalf of DPVFD.
- Doing the bare minimum is not the credence of a leader
- Leading by example – always – whether “on duty or off duty”
- Respect and alignment even when disagreements occur. We shake hands and leave as a team.
- Transparency every month through new online officer reports that all members can access anytime.
- Whether a formal rank, appointed, a black helmet or a rookie - we all can be leaders helping to move our department forward
- All officers to sign onto our mission and Vision board so we never lose sight of why we are here
- Being a servant leader to our members
- Asking the membership to hold leaders accountable to their duties including:
 - Leaders need to do more than what regular members do. This includes attending more outside training, more business meetings, more drills, and maintaining better run percentages. If members see their station officer not doing their part, they should speak up about it.

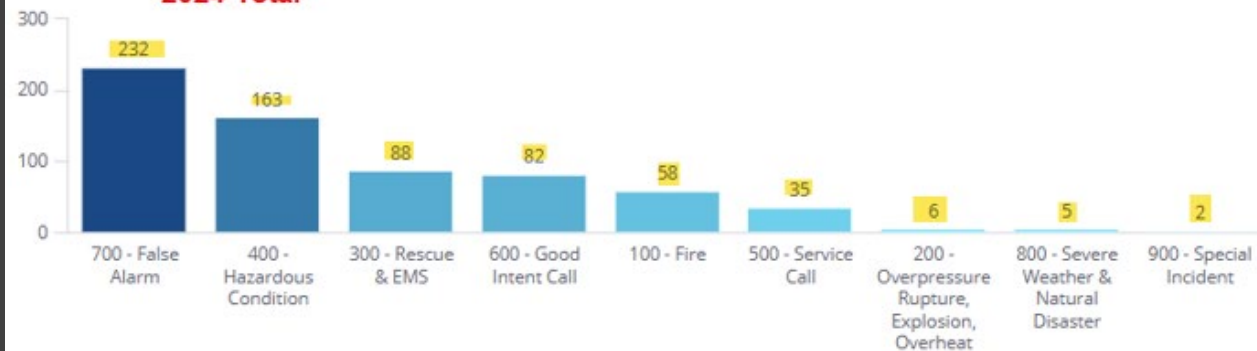

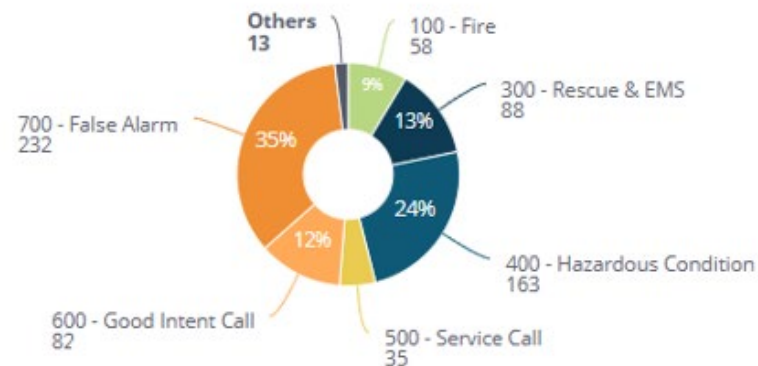

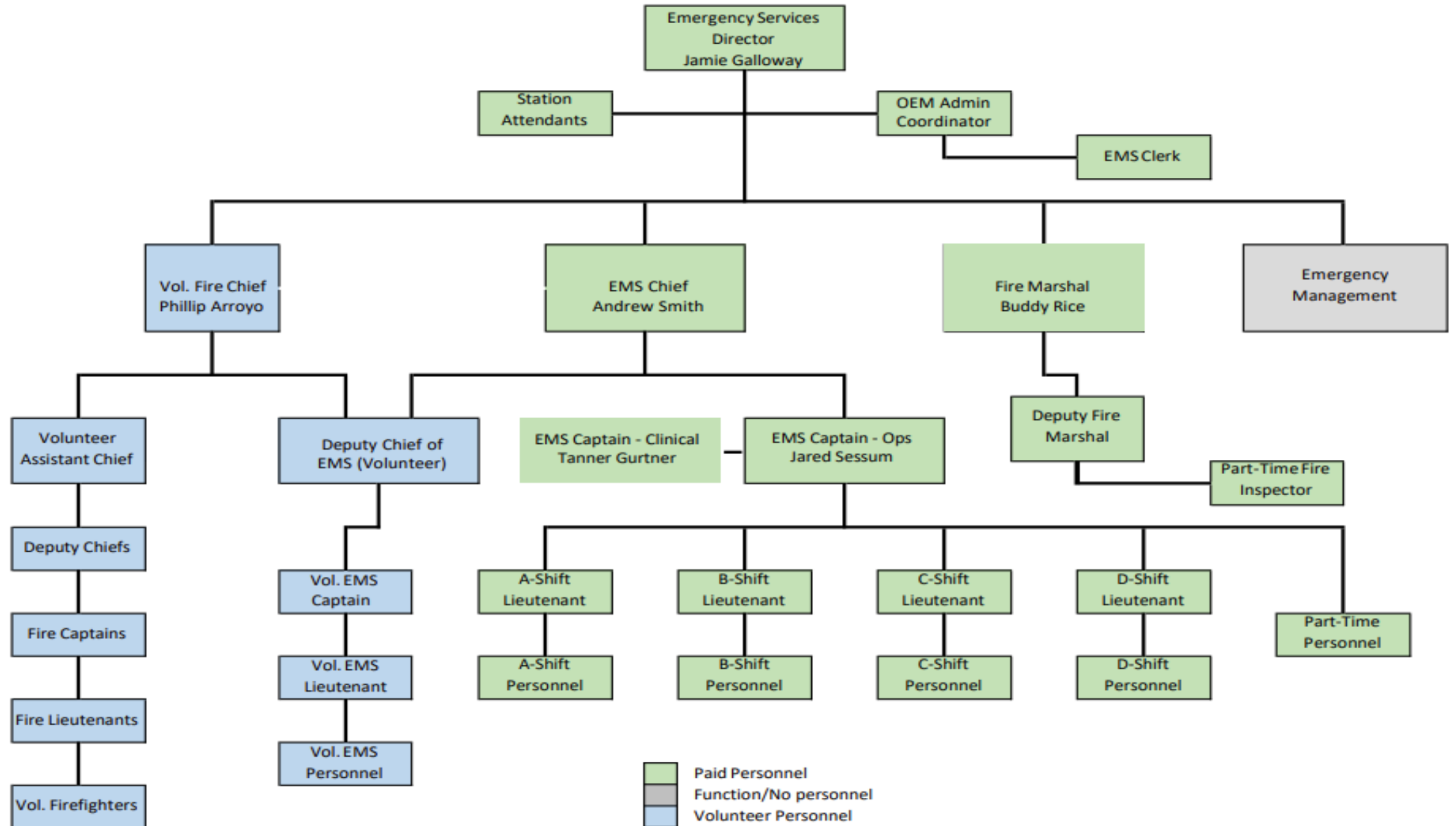

History and Path Forward



Brief History:

February 14, 2011 - Deer Park City Council passed a Resolution approving the creation of **the City of Deer Park Fire Control, Prevention and Emergency Medical Services District**. Soon thereafter, the city council appointed seven members to serve on the required FCPEMSD Temporary Board.

May 14, 2011 - voters of the City of Deer Park voted and approved the City of Deer Park Texas Fire Control, Prevention and Emergency Medical Services District, creating the imposition of a sales and use tax increase of **one-quarter of one%**.

A permanent board was appointed by City Council and charged with the development of the FCPEMSD Plan

May 7, 2016 - General and Special Elections, the Fire Control, Prevention and Emergency Medical Services District was renewed by the voters of Deer Park for **10 years**.

May 2026 – Fire Control District is set to **expire**

Current & Future:

We (FD, EMS, FMO) have been actively working in organizing an upcoming election and preparing a brochure to be distributed to the community. This brochure will highlight the positive contributions of FCPEMSD since its establishment and its ongoing efforts. Our work has taken place during both regular and special joint FCPEMSD and Crime Control meetings.

May 2025 will be an important month as this will be the date of the election where our community and DPVFD membership turns out to support an extension of FCPEMSD for **20 years**. This will help to secure projects, upgrades, improvements, facility maintenance, PPE, paid medics, current FMO staff and much more.

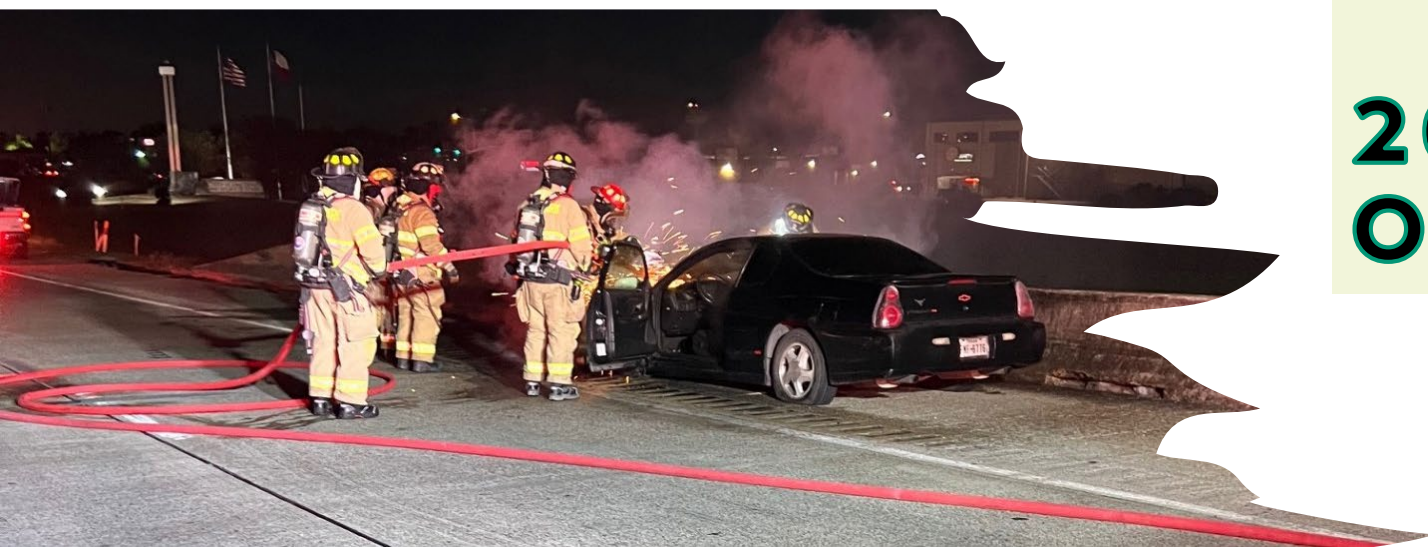
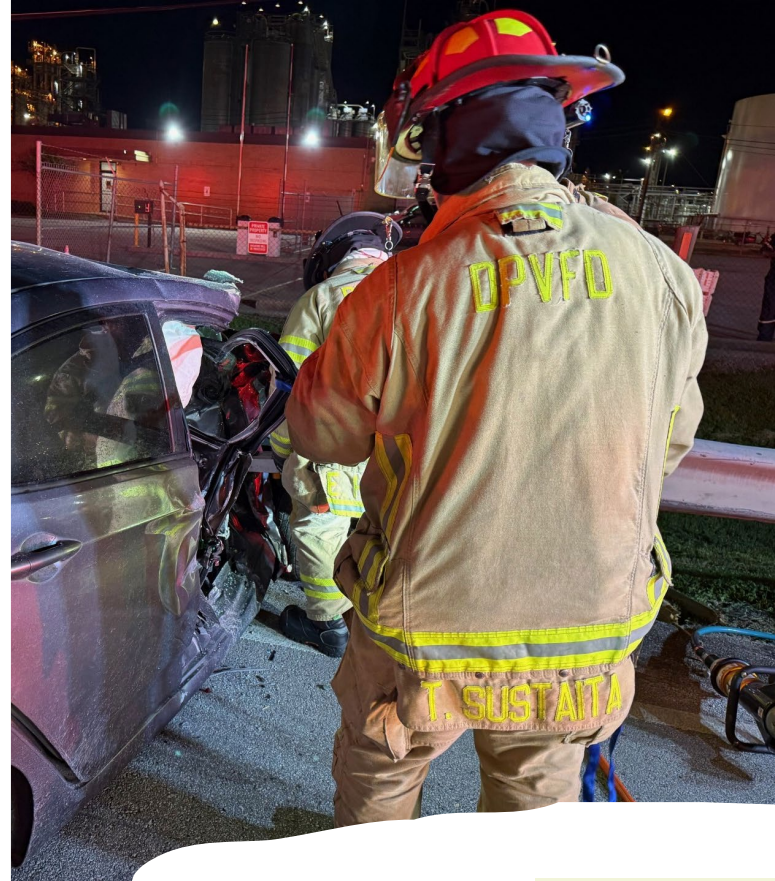
