- 1. MEETING CALLED TO ORDER President Pipkin called the meeting to order at 5:45 p.m.
- 2. COMMENTS FROM AUDIENCE No comments received.
- 3. <u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING ON OCTOBER 19, 2020</u> Motion was made by Charlie Johnson and seconded by Joe Reynolds to approve the minutes of the regular meeting on October 19, 2020. Motion carried unanimously.
- 4. PRESENTATION OF THE QUARTERLY FINANCIAL REPORT FOR THE FY 2020-2021 FIRST QUARTER ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2020 Finance Director Donna Todd gave an overview of the first preliminary and unaudited quarterly financial report for the FY 2020-2021. The total revenue of \$135,312 includes sales tax collected through October 2020. (Exhibit A1-A2)

Motion was made by Joe Reynolds and seconded by Tommy Archer to accept the quarterly financial report for the FY 2020-2021 first quarter ending December 31, 2020. Motion carried unanimously.

5. QUARTERLY REPORT REGARDING BUDGETED EXPENDITURES AND PROJECTS FOR THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR – Fire Chief Don Davis advised the Board that there is not any quarterly expenditures report.

Chief Davis commented, "We don't really have much to report this quarter. We haven't done much except for preventative maintenance on vehicles and we only have one capital project under the Fire Control and Prevention Emergency Medical Service District and that is to add an extractor and dryer at another station. We have not started on that project yet, but we will probably start in the next quarter."

Motion was made by Hal Vaughan and seconded by Joe Reynolds to accept the quarterly report regarding budgeted expenditures and projects for the current fiscal year. Motion carried unanimously.

6. <u>DISCUSSION OF FCPEMSD BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING DATES FOR FY 2020-2021</u> – Assistant City Manager Gary Jackson gave an overview of the meeting dates that are consistent with dates of the regular meetings except for the July 2021 meeting which has yet to be determined.

President Pipkin commented, "For those of you that are new to the Board, these dates on the budget are very important and are set by law. We got a certain amount of days to get these meetings in and budgets approved."

- o Preventative maintenance has been completed on all fire apparatus as well as annual pump testing
- o We have upcoming inspections on the fire ladders, fire hose, and self contained breathing apparatus.
- o We continue to purchase day to day operational supplies as needed.
- o We currently have on order 22 sets of bunker gear and will be placing an order for spare gloves, hoods and helmets.
- o The gear extractor (washer) and dryer for Station 3 are on order and should be delivered soon.
- o We are currently working on an order for some additional low pressure fire hose and low pressure nozzles.
- o We are currently working on an order to replace 13 SCBA composite bottles that their life span has expired.

- o Day to day operationing supplies, small tools and minor equipment On-going
- o Continue with annual inspection and preventative maintenance on stretchers and AED's.
- o Monthly and annual software renewal for inventory control and ordering, staff scheduling, ambulance billing and continue education training opportunities and credential tracking for all EMT's and paramedics

March 31, 2021

Authority for the Deer Park Fire Control, Prevention, and Emergency Medical Services District is provided by Texas Local Government Code, Chapter 344.

The purpose of the District is to enhance fire control and prevention and emergency medical services programs in the City of Deer Park. The fund was established by a dedicated one-fourth of one percent (0.25%) sales and use tax approved by the voters in May 2011 and effective on October 1, 2011 for a period of five years. In May 2016, voters authorized continuation of the District, including the 0.25% sales and use tax, for an additional 10 years.
