- 1. <u>MEETING CALLED TO ORDER</u> Mayor Mouton called the workshop to order at 6:45 p.m.
- 2. <u>COMMENTS FROM AUDIENCE</u> No comments received.
- 3. <u>DISCUSSION OF ISSUES RELATING TO PHASE I OF THE WAYFINDING</u> <u>PROGRAM</u> – Parks and Recreation Director Charlie Sandberg gave an overview of the history pertaining to the Phase I of the Wayfinding Program which includes repairs to signs due to vandalism, signs falling apart due to not being built to specifications, piers not built to handle wind load and utility easement and location conflicts. The status of Phase I is that all repairs have been made, specifications have been completed to meet code guidelines and utility conflicts have been corrected. Mr. Sandberg gave a recap of the 15 wayfinding signs and 4 monument signs that came to a total cost of \$166,250 and also proposed Phase II of the Way Finding Program that includes 25 additional signs and 2 large monument signs with a proposed cost of \$200,000. (Exhibit A1-A6)

Councilmembers had questions about particular signs that looked like the metal was showing. Mr. Patrick Fuller of National Sign Plaza, Inc. responded to those concerns by explaining that there could be some slippage of the sleeve that covers the metal, but an

inspection would be assessed to check on those signs and advised Council that it was just an aesthetic issue and not a structural one.

Assistant City Manager Gary Jackson commented, "Originally, there were visions of future phases beyond Phase II, but it has been determined we will not be recommending additional phases after Phase II."

4. DISCUSSION OF ISSUES RELATING TO A POSSIBLE TYPE B ELECTION ON MAY 2, 2020 – Assistant City Manager Gary Jackson gave an overview of the 7 projects that were funded by Type B funds through a combination of Certificates of Obligation and on a pay as you go basis that included the construction, renovation and acquisition of equipment capped at \$20,000,000 exclusively for the costs of financing those particular projects. Mr. Jackson advised Council of the two-phase approach concept, Phase 1 (Community Center) will house activity/program/meeting rooms and staff offices and will be constructed next door to City Hall on the site of the former City Hall. The second building, Phase 2 (Recreation Center) would house the gymnasium, indoor walking track and indoor pool to be built on the site of the current Community Center and Gymnasium after demolition of the current Community Center and Gymnasium. The estimated total project cost for the design and construction of the Community Center, Recreation Center and the new outdoor swimming pool bathhouse is estimated at \$40,200,000 with an anticipated timeline for construction of the new Community Center and Recreation Center at 44 months. The Community Center would be approximately 12,000 square feet with public spaces, program spaces, administrative offices, a service area, Recreation Division staff offices and a dance room. The Recreation Center would be approximately 48,000 square feet with Athletic staff offices, two full-size gyms, an indoor track, a fitness room and an indoor pool. The new outdoor swimming pool bathhouse is approximately 3,000 square feet. Mr. Jackson advised Council that the project is proposed to be funded by the one-half of one percent Type B economic development sales and use tax and the Certificates of Obligation (COs) would be sold to finance the project over 25 years. The exact sale of the bond is undetermined currently, but the upfront funding is estimated to be 3.5 million dollars to ensure a design concept created by the architect. The Bond Counsel recommended the ballot language be changed to include the word "complex" since the Recreation Center and Community Center are not touching. Approximately 4.5 million of existing Type B fund balance is available for additional parking at the new Soccer Complex, Girls Softball fields at the Youth Sports Complex and Spencerview Complex (Durant Fields). Since this amount is above the cap established for projects in Resolution 2015-06, the passage of the new Type B election is needed to spend these funds for this purpose.

Mayor Mouton commented, "Any aspect of these numbers that anyone may be focusing on, let's not lose sight that 70%, according to state records, of the sales tax, comes from outside of the City of Deer Park."

City Manager James Stokes advised Council that if a Special Election is called, public information will be generated and distributed to provide factual information regarding the proposed Type B sales and use tax expanded purpose authorization. This will be for informational purposes only; no City resources will be used to advocate for or against a ballot measure.

- DISCUSSION OF ISSUES RELATING TO AN AGREEENT WITH HARRIS COUNTY 5. THE HURRICANE HARVEY CDBG-DR BAYOU BEND REGIONAL FOR DETENTION FACILITY AND DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT - Assistant City Manager Gary Jackson advised Council that submission of a grant application was approved in 2018. The proposed agreement is with Harris County which distributes the funds to different cities to which the City of Deer Park is a sub-grantee. This grant will provide 2.9 million dollars for assisting with Hurricane Harvey related drainage issues that will have to be spent on low to moderate income areas. The focus will be on Bayou Bend Park with Harris County contracting the engineering services for the design estimated at \$348,000 with an approximate 2.5 million dollars to be utilized for the completion of the project.
- 6. <u>ADJOURN</u> Mayor Mouton adjourned the workshop meeting at 7:24 p.m.

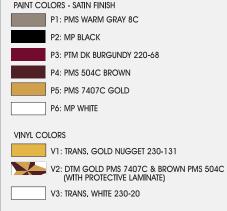

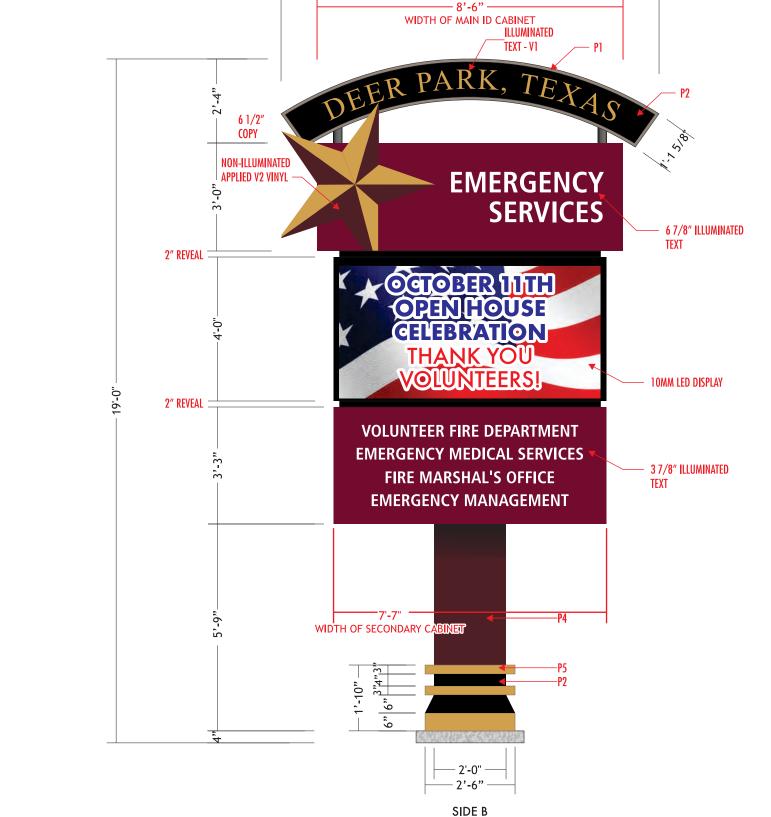

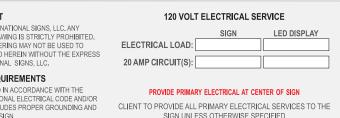

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR JOINT ELECTION

THE STATE OF TEXAS §

COUNTY OF HARRIS §

This Agreement is made and entered into by and between the CITY OF DEER PARK (hereinafter "City") and the DEER PARK INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT (hereinafter "District").

WITNESETH

This agreement is made and entered into under the authority of the Texas Interlocal Cooperation Act, codified as Chapter 791. Texas Government Code and Chapter 271, "Joint Elections", of the Texas Election Code.

That the City and the District, being two political subdivisions of the State of Texas, are authorized by the provisions of Section 271.002 of the Texas Election Code to hold a Joint Election as follows:

- A. The election for each political subdivision is to be held on the same day, the first Saturday in the month of May.
- B. Election for each political subdivision shall be served by a common polling place or places.
- C. The terms of the Joint Election Agreement are as follows:
 - 1. The City shall provide the District a space/location in the Deer Park Community Center for the District's election equipment, machines and personnel for the May election.
 - 2. The City waives all charges for the use of the space/location for said election.

This agreement shall be for the General Election of the City Council, and Board of Trustee members, and any special election held on the 1st Saturday of May by the parties hereto. Should the City and District be subject to a runoff election after the general/special election held on the 1st Saturday in May, this agreement would be continued if both entities elect the same date for a runoff election.

This agreement shall be effective for the General/Special election by the parties hereto, and for any necessary runoff election. This agreement shall automatically renew thereafter on a year to year basis. A party to this agreement may withdraw from this agreement by giving written notice to the other party hereto on or before December 1 of the year preceding the next election for both parties, to be held on the 1st Saturday of May in an election year in which both entities are authorized under law to have a General Election for Trustees/ City Council.

This agreement has been approved by the respective governing boards of the parties hereto.

IN TESTAMONY WHEREOF, the undersigned are the duly authorized representatives of the parties to this agreement, and their signatures represent adoption and acceptance of the terms and conditions of this agreement.

Consideration of and action on an ordinance to amend the Fiscal Year 2018-2019 Budget for the Emergency Management Department and the Emergency Medical Services Department.

Summary:

The Fiscal Year 2018-2019 Budget included overtime costs for employees of the Emergency Management Department and the Emergency Medical Services Department. In the Emergency Management Department, the total cost of overtime for the fiscal year exceeded the budget estimate due to the additional manpower dedicated to the fire at the Intercontinental Terminals Company (ITC) Deer Park facility in March 2019 resulting in a net variance of approximately \$2,800.00. In the Emergency Medical Services Department, the total cost of overtime for the fiscal year exceeded the budget estimate due to the additional hours required to cover for staff turnover and vacancies resulting in a net variance of approximately \$21,000.00. A budget amendment in the amount of \$2,800.00 is requested to appropriate the additional funds necessary to fully fund the Emergency Medical Services Department for the fiscal year. A budget amendment in the amount of \$21,000.00 is requested to appropriate the additional appropriations, totaling \$23,800.00, would be funded by the unassigned fund balance of the General Fund.

Fiscal/Budgetary Impact:

Add \$2,800.00 to the Fiscal Year 2018-2019 budget for the Emergency Management Department (Account No. 010-310-41040, Salaries Overtime) and \$21,000.00 to the Fiscal Year 2018-2019 budget for the Emergency Medical Services Department (Account No. 010-312-41040, Salaries Overtime), with the total \$23,800.00 to be funded by the unassigned fund balance of the General

Fund, which is available for this purpose.

Approve the ordinance to amend the Fiscal Year 2018-2019 Budget for the Emergency Management Department and the Emergency Medical Services Department.

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2018-2019 BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF DEER PARK, TEXAS, AND APPROPRIATING THE SUMS SET UP THEREIN TO THE OBJECTS AND PURPOSES THEREIN NAMED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEER PARK:

I.

That the City of Deer Park's budget for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019 was duly prepared and filed with the City Secretary, where it was available for inspection by any taxpayer.

II.

That the budget for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019 included personnel costs, which include overtime in most departments.

III.

That in the Emergency Management Department, the total cost of overtime for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019 exceeded the budget estimate due to the additional manpower dedicated to the fire at the Intercontinental Terminals Company (ITC) Deer Park facility in March 2019 resulting in a net variance of approximately \$2,800.00.

IV.

That in the Emergency Medical Services Department, the total cost of overtime for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019 exceeded the budget estimate due to the additional hours required to cover for staff turnover and vacancies resulting in a net variance of approximately \$21,000.00.

V.

That it is necessary to amend the General Fund budget for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019 to appropriate an additional \$2,800.00 and \$21,000.00, respectively, to fully fund the expenditures of the Emergency Management Department and the Emergency Medical Services Department for the fiscal

That funding for the amendment to the expenditures of the adopted budgets of the Emergency Management Department and the Emergency Medical Services Department will include the amounts of \$2,800.00 and \$21,000.00, respectively, from the unassigned fund balance of the General Fund.

VII.

That the regular budget of the City of Deer Park, Texas, for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019, be, and the same is hereby, in all respects finally approved and amended as so described and shall be, and is hereby, filed with the City Secretary of said City.

VIII.

That the amounts specified are for the purposes named in said budget, and they are hereby appropriated to and for such purposes.

IX.

That the City Secretary file copies of this Ordinance and of such budget with all public officers as required by the laws of the State of Texas.

X.

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was adopted was open to the public, and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given, all as required by Chapter 551 of the Government Code of the State of Texas.

XI.
