AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2016-2017 BUDGET FOR THE DEER PARK FIRE CONTROL, PREVENTION AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES DISTRICT, AND APPROPRIATING THE SUMS SET UP THEREIN TO THE OBJECTS AND PURPOSES THEREIN

NAMED; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEER PARK:

1. That the budget for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016 for the Deer Park Fire Control,

Prevention and Emergency Medical Services District, a component unit of the City, was approved by the Deer

Park Fire Control, Prevention and Emergency Medical Services District Board of Directors and the City of Deer

Park City Council, and was filed with the City Secretary and District Board Secretary, where it was available for

inspection by any taxpayer.

2. That the budget for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016 for the Deer Park Fire Control,

Prevention and Emergency Medical Services District included the amount of \$70,000 for protective clothing,

which includes personal protective equipment.

3. That \$62,000 of personal protective equipment was ordered during the fiscal year ending

September 30, 2016 but was not received by the Deer Park Fire Control, Prevention and Emergency Medical

Services District until after the start of the new fiscal year ending September 30, 2017.

4. That the budget for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2017 for the Deer Park Fire Control,

Prevention and Emergency Medical Services District was approved by the Deer Park Fire Control, Prevention

and Emergency Medical Services District Board of Directors and the City of Deer Park City Council, and was

filed with the City Secretary and District Board Secretary, where it was available for inspection by any taxpayer.

5. That the Deer Park Fire Control, Prevention and Emergency Medical Services District Budget

for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2017 should be amended to include the amount of \$62,000 for personal

protective equipment ordered but not received during the previous fiscal year ending September 30, 2016.

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6. That the expenditure amount of \$62,000 for the cost of personal protective equipment will be

funded out of the prior year revenues of the Deer Park Fire Control, Prevention and Emergency Medical

Services District, which are available for this purpose.

7. That the Deer Park Fire Control, Prevention and Emergency Medical Services District Board of

Directors voted on January 16, 2017 to amend the Deer Park Fire Control, Prevention and Emergency Medical

Services District Budget for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2017 in the amount of \$62,000 for the cost of

personal protective equipment.

**8.** That an amendment to the Deer Park Fire Control, Prevention and Emergency Medical Services

District Budget requires approval by both the Deer Park Fire Control, Prevention and Emergency Medical

Services District Board of Directors and the City of Deer Park City Council.

9. That the budget of the Deer Park Fire Control, Prevention and Emergency Medical Services

District, for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2017, be, and the same is hereby, in all respects finally

approved and amended as so described above, and the same shall be, and is hereby, filed with the City Secretary

of the City of Deer Park and the Board Secretary of the Deer Park Fire Control, Prevention and Emergency

Medical Services District.

10. That the amount specified is for the purpose named in said budget, and is hereby appropriated to

and for such purpose.

11. That the City Secretary file copies of this Ordinance and of such budget with all public officers

as required by the laws of the State of Texas.

12. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was

adopted was open to the public, and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given,

all as required by Chapter 551, Government Code of the State of Texas.

13. The City Council finds that this Ordinance relates to the immediate preservation of the public

peace, health, safety and welfare, in that the City's budget, including the budget of any and all component units,

should be adopted at the earliest possible moment to comply with the City Charter and Statutes of the State of

Texas, and to provide funds for uninterrupted police, fire and sanitary protection, and to continue the essential

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services of water supply, garbage, and sewage disposal, thereby creating an emergency, for which the Charter requirement providing for the reading of ordinances on three (3) several days should be dispensed with, and this Ordinance be passed finally on its introduction, and, accordingly, such requirement is dispensed with, and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
