ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DEER PARK SETTING A DATE AND TIME FOR A PUBLIC HEARING OF THE PROPOSED BUDGET FOR THE YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2018 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2019; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEER PARK:

I.

"Pursuant to the provisions of Section 102.006 of The Local Government Code of the State of Texas, the City Council of the City of Deer Park, Texas, has called, and does hereby call, a Public Hearing to be held on the 21st day of August 2018, at 7:30 o'clock p.m. in the City Council Chamber at the City Hall of said City at 710 E. San Augustine Street in said City, at which time and place they will hear all persons desiring to be heard on or in connection with any matter or question involving the proposed budget for said City for the year beginning October 1, 2018 and ending September 30, 2019, which has been filed with the City Secretary and is available for inspection by all interested persons."

II.

The City Secretary is hereby directed to give notice of said hearing to the public as required by law.

III.

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was adopted was open to the public, and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given, all as required by Chapter 551, Government Code of the State of Texas.

IV.

The City Council finds that this Ordinance relates to the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare, in that the City's budget should be adopted at the earliest possible moment to comply with the State Law and the City Charter, and to provide funds to continue uninterrupted police, fire and sanitary protection, and the essential services of water supply, garbage, and sewage disposal,

Hearing Budget 2018-2019 thereby creating an emergency, for which the Charter requirement providing for the reading of Ordinances on three (3) several days should be dispensed with, and this Ordinance be passed finally on its introduction; and, accordingly, such requirement is dispensed with, and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
