1. MEETING CALLED TO ORDER – Mayor Mouton called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.
2. INVOCATION – The invocation was given by Councilman Patterson.
3. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE – Councilman Martin led the Pledge of Allegiance to the United States Flag and the Texas Flag.
4. CONSENT CALENDAR – Motion was made by Councilman Ginn and seconded by Councilwoman Sinor to approve the consent calendar as follows:
  - a. Approval of minutes of budget workshop meeting on June 25, 2018.
  - b. Approval of minutes of workshop meeting on July 10, 2018.
  - c. Approval of minutes of regular meeting on July 10, 2018.
  - d. Acceptance of certification of the anticipated Tax Collection Rate.
  - e. Authorization of written consent for assignment of the Chapter 380 Agreement with Cencor Acquisition Company, Inc. to NEC Spencer Highway and East Boulevard.

- f. Authorization to advertise and receive bids for 13<sup>th</sup> Street and Underwood paving improvements. (north lanes)

Motion carried 7 to 0.

- 5. CONSIDERATION OF AND ACTION ON A CONTRACT WITH THE ECONOMIC ALLIANCE HOUSTON PORT REGION FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT SERVICES – Motion was made by Councilman Patterson and seconded by Councilwoman Garrison to approve entering into a contract with the Economic Alliance Houston Port Region for economic development services. Motion carried 7 to 0.
- 6. CONSIDERATION OF AND ACTION ON AN AGREEMENT TO RENEW THE SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICERS (SRO)/CROSSING GUARD INTER-LOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE DEER PARK INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT (DPISD) FOR THE 2018/19 SCHOOL YEAR – Motion was made by Councilman Harrison and seconded by Councilman Patterson to enter into an agreement to renew the School Resource Officers (SRO)/Crossing Guard Inter-Local Agreement with Deer Park Independent School District (DPISD) for the 2018/19 school year. Motion carried 7 to 0.
- 7. CONSIDERATION OF AND ACTION ON AUTHORIZATION TO PURCHASE PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT FOR PARKVIEW PARK AND BIG BEND PARK – Motion was made by Councilwoman Sinor and seconded by Councilman Patterson to authorize the purchase of playground equipment for Parkview Park and Big Bend Park. Motion carried 7 to 0.
- 8. CONSIDERATION OF AND ACTION ON AN ORDINANCE CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED FY 2018-2019 CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION DISTRICT BUDGET – After a proposed ordinance was read by caption, motion was made by Councilman Martin and seconded by Councilman Ginn to approve Ordinance No. 3991, captioned as follows:
