1. MEETING CALLED TO ORDER – Chairman Balusek called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.
2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – Motion was made by Commissioner Wendeburg and seconded by Commissioner Cox to approve the minutes as follows:
 - a. Approval of minutes of regular meeting held on July 1, 2019.Motion carried 4 to 0.

3. CONSIDERATION OF AND ACTION ON THE RESULTS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING ON THE REQUEST OF THE PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE ZONING ORDINANCE BY ALLOWING LAYDOWN YARDS IN M3 DISTRICT; ADDING USE GROUPS 34 AND 35 TO PRINCIPAL USES IN M3 DISTRICT; INCLUDING OFFICE WAREHOUSE OR DISTRIBUTION CENTER AS PERMITTED USE IN THE M3 DISTRICT; REQUIRING A SPECIFIC USE PERMIT – Motion was made by Commissioner Tippit and seconded by Commissioner Cox to make a recommendation to City Council to approve the request of the proposed amendments to the Zoning Ordinance by allowing laydown yards in M3 District; adding Use Groups 34 and 35 to principal uses in M3 District; including office warehouse or distribution center as permitted use in the M3 District; requiring a Specific Use Permit. Motion carried 4 to 0.

4. CONSIDERATION OF AND ACTION ON THE RESULTS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING ON THE REQUEST OF THE PROPOSED ESTABLISHMENT OF A ZONE DESIGNATION FOR INTENSIVE INDUSTRIAL (M3) DISTRICT – Motion was made by Commissioner Wendeburg and seconded by Commissioner Cox to make a recommendation to City Council to approve the request of the proposed establishment of a zone designation for Intensive Industrial (M3) District. Motion carried 4 to 0.
5. CONSIDERATION OF AND ACTION ON THE RESULTS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING ON THE REQUEST OF MOLTO PROPERTIES FOR A SPECIFIC USE PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT A BULK WAREHOUSE AT 739 INDEPENDENCE PARKWAY – Motion was made by Commissioner Cox and seconded by Commissioner Tippit to make a recommendation to City Council to approve the request of Molto Properties for a Specific Use Permit to construct a bulk warehouse at 739 Independence Parkway. Motion carried 4 to 0.
