- 1. <u>MEETING CALLED TO ORDER</u> Commissioner Balusek called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m
- 2. <u>RECESS/RECONVENE</u> Commissioner Balusek recessed the regular Planning and Zoning meeting at 6:30 p.m. to continue the Preliminary Public Hearing and reconvened the meeting at 6:44 p.m.

   Motion was made by Commissioner Balusek and seconded by Commissioner Garrett to change the meeting date of September 3, 2018 to September 10, 2018 due to the Labor Day Holiday. Motion carried 5 to 0.
- 6. CONSIDERATION OF AND ACTION ON THE RESULT FROM THE PUBLIC HEARING
  ON THE REQUEST OF PAUL SINGH TO REZONE THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT
  1701 EAST BOULEVARD FROM SINGLE FAMILY 1 (SF1) TO GENERAL
  COMMERCIAL (GC) Motion was made by Commissioner Wendeburg and seconded by
  Commissioner Garrett to make a recommendation to City Council to approve the request of
  Paul Singh to rezone the property located at 1701 East Boulevard from Single Family (SF1) to

General Commercial.

Commissioner Balusek commented, "I do not see any residential possibilities over there. I think that would have hindered not approving this. I think when East Boulevard was constructed, the primary purpose was to move the commercial traffic from Center Street towards East Boulevard. This would allow that. I will vote in favor of recommending this be rezoned."
