


1. MEETING CALLED TO ORDER – Chairman Balusek called the meeting to order at 6:28 p.m.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – Motion was made by Commissioner Cox and seconded by Commissioner Tippit to approve the minutes as follows:

CONSIDERATION OF AND ACTION ON THE RESULTS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING ON THEREQUEST FROM GREGORY DUPIN FOR AN ELEVEN (11) FOOT SIX (6) INCH VARIANCE TO THE WIDTH OF A DRIVEWAY TO BE CONSTRUCTED AT 2502 TAYLOR LANE – Motion was made by Commissioner Cox and seconded by Commissioner Garret to approve the request from Gregory Dupin for an eleven (11) foot six (6) inch variance to the width of a driveway to be constructed at 2502 Taylor Lane. Motion carried 5 to 0.
