Discussion of issues relating to an ordinance amending the fee schedule for water and sewer deposits.

### Summary:

The City has recently evaluated the fee schedule related to water and sewer deposits. There were inconsistencies in the deposit requirements for residential customers, multifamily residential customers (e.g., apartments), and commercial customers. It was apparent that some of these deposit amounts had not been reviewed or updated for many years. In an effort to update the deposit requirements to protect the City and to apply a consistent standard, the following changes to the fee schedule are being proposed and will be presented in an ordinance for consideration in the regular City Council meeting to follow:

The fee schedule in Appendix B changes would be:

Section 106-24(a)(1)

Water and sewer deposits for residential customer ~~\$100.00~~ \$125.00

Additional deposit for delinquent customer           \$10.00   \$25.00

Section 106-24(b)(2)

Water and sewer deposits for multifamily residential customers, per residential unit ~~\$15.00~~ \$125.00

Based on usage, additional fees may be assessed by utility manager

Section 106-24(c)

Water and sewer deposits for commercial customer ~~\$30.00~~ \$125.00

Based on usage, additional fees may be assessed by utility manager

Increase in water and sewer deposits.
